

## **TESL & MANDARIN TRAINING FOR PEOPLE GOING TO TEACH IN CHINA**

Are you going to China to teach English or other subjects at the university level and need some teacher and language training as well as orientation to Chinese society and culture? The Colorado China Council (CCC) is now offering its training program to non-CCC teachers. In other words, if you already have a university placement but still NEED TRAINING you may attend our August intensive Shanghai Summer Teacher Training and Language Institute (SI), circa July 30-August 21, 2010. Our Chinese host, for the past 14 years, is Shanghai University's Sydney Institute of Language and Commerce. You will have a private room and bath at the Shanghai University Guest House on campus that is very close to your classrooms.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** The SI is limited to the first 20 qualified applicants who are under contract to teach at a Chinese universities whether they are CCC applicants, sponsored by Consortium universities or independents.

**DEADLINE FOR APPLICATIONS:** Postmarked by April 1, 2010 or until all 20 positions are filled.

**PROGRAM FEES:** \$2,350. Check should be made out to the Colorado China Council. **LATE FEES:** Add \$100.00 for each month after April 1<sup>st</sup>. Everything is included in these fees except food and items of a personal nature such as laundry, cell phone etc.

**FEES INCLUDE:** Three week intensive teacher training institute in Shanghai including: TESL training, China orientation, class room management, lesson planning, books and materials, practicum with volunteer Chinese students, Mandarin language study, tuition, private room and bath at the university guest house, airport pickup and drop off, lots of incredible sightseeing, Shanghai acrobats, boat trip, banquet, and all transportation to group events while in Shanghai.

**PARTICIPANTS:** People who participate in our SI come from top universities and colleges throughout the USA and are either professionals such as lawyers and engineers or teachers. Occasionally we can still accept younger, recent college graduates.

**DOCUMENTATION:** Along with your check for \$2,350 please submit:

1. Resume focused on your academic background including any Mandarin language ability so that we can place you in the appropriate language class.
2. Picture page of your passport
3. A full-length photo of yourself without hat or sunglasses for use when we pick you up at the airport as thousands of people deplane.
